

Justice Rescue's Adoption Contract – What to Expect regarding Justice Rescue's Adoption Contract:

- I understand that the animal being adopted is a “rescued” animal and Justice Rescue cannot make any guarantees about the animal’s previous care, treatment, or history.
- I understand and agree that while Justice Rescue makes every effort to place only healthy and sound animals, Justice Rescue cannot guarantee the health of any animal. Justice Rescue shall not be held responsible for any medical expense which may be incurred, hereby expressly excluding any implied or express warranties, merchantability, or fitness for any particular purpose, including without limitation and warranties regarding health, temperament or whether the animal is housebroken.
- I agree that the animal is being adopted for myself and will not be sold, adopted, or given to another party.
- I agree that the animal will not be allowed outdoors without proper supervision. When taking my dog outdoors outside of a fence, they will be on a secure harness and wear proper ID.
- (If adopting a cat) I agree that I will not declaw the cat or allow the cat outdoors.
- (If adopting a dog) I agree that this dog is to be a companion animal, not a guard dog. The dog will live inside my home, not outdoors.
- I agree to care for the animal in a humane manner and be a responsible animal guardian. This includes supplying adequate food, water, shelter, attention, and medical care. This includes never allowing my pet outside unattended.
- I agree that if at any point I cannot keep the animal, I will return him/her to Justice Rescue, to the same location where I picked up my pet. **Justice Rescue must be given 10 days** advance notice to find an appropriate foster home for the animal being returned. If Justice Rescue is able to take the animal back sooner than that, they will do so. If you cannot give ten days’ notice, I will be subjected to boarding costs.
- I understand and agree that Justice Rescue makes no guarantees about the animal's health and is not responsible for any future medical costs incurred by the animal. The dog/cat is adopted “as is” and the adopter assumes all responsibility for the treatment of all existing conditions or any other conditions or physical changes that may occur.
- I understand and agree that Justice Rescue makes no guarantees about the animal's temperament and is not responsible for future damages or injuries caused by the animal. The dog/cat is adopted “as is” and the adopter assumes all responsibility for any existing or future temperament changes that may occur.
- I understand and agree that Justice Rescue makes no guarantees about the animal's breed or breed mix. All information provided by Justice Rescue regarding an animal’s breed type is a best guess and has not been confirmed.
- I give Justice Rescue permission to call my home at any reasonable time to assure that the animal is being cared for and treated properly, and to allow a home-visit by a Justice Rescue representative.
- I agree to keep Justice Rescue informed of my current home address and phone number.
- I agree to keep the animal up-to-date on all vaccinations and to give the animal monthly heartworm preventative and flea/tick preventative, and to seek veterinary care for all medical needs.
- I understand that Justice Rescue does NOT refund adoption fees if the pet is returned.
